General Frame of the Polimi Design Summer School // 2018, 27th of August - 8th of September

#### Theme

This program is based on the method of acquiring and sharing knowledge through the direct physical experience of places, team work, and design practice. In this frame, our activities will focus on existing buildings or spaces that have a specific architectural, or historical, or political, or emotional value, and that are worth to be analyzed and restored, improved, transformed, enlarged, completed. Each joint workshop will precise its themes and goals.

## **Schedule**

The Summer School is made of 3 parallel design joint workshops made in association with Est European schools of architecture and design: each workshop will have two consecutive sessions of 5 days each: the first will be in the foreign hosting School, the second at Polimi. Each joint workshop will have 1-2 teachers and 5-8 students from Polimi, 1-2 teachers and 5-8 students from the partner institution.

### Calendar

Workshops will be composed of two separate sessions. The first sessions will be separately hosted at the partner institutions (Moscow, Kaunas, Warsaw) from the 27<sup>th</sup> to the 31<sup>th</sup> of August.

The second session, jointed for the three workshop, will be held at Polimi Leonardo Campus, in Milan, from the 3<sup>rd</sup> to the 8<sup>th</sup> of September. Here, guest professors and students will find for free workplace, free accommodation, guided tours. The last day, an instant exhibit will show the workshops production.

## Costs

Each institution will pay salaries of its own professors and tutors.

Polimi offers general organization, workspace for the Italian session, and accommodation in Milan for foreign professors and students; partner institutions should offer workspace, Polimi professors and students' hospitality with free (or low cost), accommodation.
