

REGULATIONS STUDENT EXCHANGE 2022

BETWEEN
FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE, WARSAW UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY AND
SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE, UNIVERSITY OF DETROIT MERCY

Eligibility rules for the 2022 outbound Detroit group.

The qualification will take place in two stages:

1. preliminary stage in January 2022
2. final stage after the English language qualifying examination

Requirements for candidates

The qualification is open to 3rd year students of engineering studies (in Polish and in English) at WAPW. This year's recruitment will include second year students who were recruited for the trip last year without having to re-enter the recruitment process. These students are requested to declare their willingness to participate in this year's recruitment by completing and signing all documents required during the recruitment process with the note: "recruitment 2021".

Initial qualification

People who send the following documents by e-mail to katarzyna.mitroszewska@pw.edu.pl by January 10, 2022 are invited to pre-qualify:

1. registration card;
2. signed financial commitment;
3. signed exchange regulations.

Shortlisted candidates are required to provide the originals of the above-mentioned documents to the Dean's Office of WAPW.

The pre-selection process aims to select from among the applicants a total of 9 students, who have achieved the highest number of points in their group. They will participate in classes conducted at the WUT for the Polish-American group.

Candidates are qualified on the basis of the number of points obtained, from the highest to the lowest. The number of points is the sum of the product of the grade for the course and the number of ECTS points allocated to it from the following design classes:

- sem. III. Architectural design 1 (Architecture in Landscape);
- sem. III. Elements of Urban Composition;
- sem. IV Architectural design 2 (Single Family House);
- sem. IV Interior Design;

Final Qualification

As a result of the final qualification, 7 students will be selected for the trip to Detroit and two additional standby people who will step in in case of random events. The number of participants may change after the end of the enrollment at the University of Detroit Mercy.

Exchange participants should know English sufficiently to enable them to communicate

freely. For this purpose, a qualifying examination will be conducted. People who have completed the technical English language course at WA PW with a grade: 4; 4.5; 5 - are exempt from the exam and the grade is included in the overall score.

Certificates entitling to exemption from the exam:

- CAE with a score of A or B or C; the grades included in the total score are respectively: 5 or 4.5 or 4 included in the total score.
- CPE with a score of A, B, C; the grade included in the overall score is 5.
- TOEFL (Internet-based test) with a score of 110 - the overall score is 5, from 102 - 4.5, from 79 - 4. The certificate must be valid on the day of the language exam.
- IELTS with a score of 8 - the grade included in the overall score is 5, from 7.5 - 4.5, from 6.5 - 4. The certificate must be valid on the day of the language exam.
- International Baccalaureate (IB) - the grade included in the overall score is 5.
- University C1 Academic Examination (not general!).

Persons exempted from the exam should report within the prescribed period to Magdalena Walenty, PhD in order to confirm the certificate validity.

The total score in the pre-selection stage is increased by multiplying the grade of the English language exam by 6 ECTS points.

Candidates are selected on the basis of the number of points consecutively from the highest to the lowest.

Candidates subject to final qualification are required to fulfill the following conditions:

- completion of all other subjects and internships from the entire current study program (completed semesters of studies - confirmed by the Dean's Office on the registration card) and obtaining absolute registration for the summer semester in February 2022 in the academic year 2021/2022;
- fulfillment of financial commitments (does not apply to students from the standby list - these will be required to pay after possible entry on the final list);
- payment of tuition fees for the 2020/21 summer semester by students of English-speaking and extramural studies. Students of English-speaking and extramural studies enrolled in the study may apply to the Dean of WA WUT for an exemption from tuition fees for the 2022/2023 winter semester.

The final list of students qualified for the exchange will be announced after the English language exam no later than May 2022.

Costs

The trip is organized on a self-financing basis. The cost is approx. PLN 8,700 (payable in 3 installments). The above cost does not include the price of the plane ticket and visa fees.
