- 8. List the regional types of early Christian basilicas and characterize a chosen one.
- 9. Name the most popular type of Byzantine church and define its main features.
- 10. List the Greek and Roman orders and discuss the main differences between them.
- 11. Discuss the basic features of German Romanesque architecture.
- 12. Discuss the main differences between the Early and High Gothic styles in France.
- 13. Discuss three early modern residential architecture types in Italy and characterize a chosen type.
- 14. Based on a chosen example, discuss the architecture of Italian Mannerism.
- 15. Based on a chosen example, discuss the type of residence entre cour et jardin.
- 16. Based on a chosen example, discuss the main features of so-called *Revolutionary Neoclassicism*.
- 17. List the phases of 19th century Historicism and characterize one of them on a chosen example.
- 18. Discuss the features of Art Nouveau in architecture based on a chosen example.
- 19. Give the main centres of Art Nouveau in Europe (at least three), along with examples of objects and their creators.
- 20. Discuss a chosen example of monumental wall decorations used in any period throughout the ages.
- 21. List and discuss the methods of obtaining visual depth in early modern painting.
- 22. List at least five avant-garde artistic movements in the art of the first half of the 20th century and discuss the premises of one of them.
- 23. List three artistic movements in the art of the second half of the 20th century and discuss the premises of one of them.
- 24. Explain what MODULOR was, why it was created and by whom.
- 25. List three chosen Polish pavilions at international exhibitions and discuss one of them in detail.
- 26. Give the basic premise of socialist realism in architecture and list three architectural and urban schemes completed in this way in Warsaw.
- 27. Discuss the aims and activity of CIAM, and give its most prominent representatives.
- 28. Give and describe the type of building called HOUSING UNIT and give a Polish example that follows this scheme.
- 29. Give three formal features that distinguish objects that belong to the so-called International Style.
- 30. Based on chosen examples from Polish lands, discuss and compare the spatial structure of a Romanesque basilica of the Saxon and the Rhine type.
- 31. Please describe the architecture, structure and functional-spatial layout of 13th-century Cistercian monasteries in Małopolska.

- 32. Discuss and compare the spatial layout and structural solutions of 14th-century Gothic cathedrals in Kraków and Gniezno.
- 33. On the example of chosen religious objects founded by Kazimierz Wielki characterize their architecture and spatial solutions.
- 34. Characterize the basic features of architecture, spatial structure and functional scheme of a Teutonic Order's conventual castle.
- 35. Define and discuss Gothic-Renaissance and Renaissance elements in the architecture of the Wawel Castle in Kraków.
- 36. Discuss the main features of mannerist architecture in northern Poland.
- 37. List and characterize the architecture and spatial layout of Late Baroque royal residences in Warsaw.
- 38. Provide some examples and discuss the architecture of religious and residential buildings completed in Warsaw by Tylman van Gameren (17th century).
- 39. Discuss the architecture of the main buildings completed in the second half of the 18th century in Łazienki Królewskie in Warsaw.
- 40. Discuss the origin of the so-called "manorial style"? (Dwór Style?) and its applications in the architecture of Warsaw residential estates of the 1920s.
- 41. Define the term "Hippodamian urban planning" and characterize one example of an ancient city planned according to its premises.
- 42. On the example of a chosen city, discuss the main elements of the scheme of the Roman camp castrum Romanum following the Roman system of founding cities.
- 43. Discuss the action of founding cities in the Middle Ages in Silesia and give an example of a city established at that time.
- 44. Say which type of medieval city did not have a market and characterize it using a chosen example.
- 45. On the example of a chosen city, characterize the so-called inner-market block its objects and their functions.
- 46. Please specify what the founding of an urban settlement was according to granting a town charter in the Middle Ages.
- 47. Characterize an example of a Polish city from the Renaissance, the founding of which was inspired by a theoretical treatise.
- 48. List and characterize 18th century great urban axes of Warsaw.
- 49. Characterize the great replanning of Paris in 1853-1869, and say who initiated and completed it.
- 50. Characterize the basic features of planning of Łódź town in the times of the Congress Kingdom of Poland.
