TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF USING THE ISOLATION ROOM NO. 6 (ground floor, wing of building from the side of ul. Lwowska) are valid from 1st October 2020 and have been implemented in relation to Regulation no. 104/2020 issued by the PW Rector on 30th September 2020.

- 1. The isolation room is accessible only for a person with symptoms suggesting communicable disease (temperature above 37°C, running nose, coughing, no sense of smell, etc.), as well as for medical service and health and epidemiology service.
- 2. No objects can be brought inside the room.
- 3. Use of cell phones is recommended only in emergencies.
- 4. The room is open during WAPW working hours and outside of those hours in case when a patient is occupying within the room until the medical procedures are completed.
- 5. Max. 5 persons can occupy the room at the same time.
- 6. People entering the room must disinfect hands using disinfectant located at the entrance to the room and wear a mask covering mouth and nose, as well as disposable gloves.
- 7. People entering the room should sit on indicated places while maintaining a 1.5 m (5 ft) distance.
- 8. Moving furniture located in the room, in particular chairs and armchairs, is absolutely forbidden.
- 9. You can stay in the room until medical procedures or health and epidemiology activities are concluded by services performing them or until you receive appropriate guidance from the said services.
- 10. The timespan between exit of one group with symptoms and entrance of another group must amount to min. 60 minutes.
- 11. The room will be ventilated and disinfected according to the recommendations of health and epidemiology service during the said break.
