

REGULATIONS STUDENT EXCHANGE 2021

BETWEEN

FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE, WARSAW UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY AND
SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE, UNIVERSITY OF DETROIT MERCY

Eligibility rules for the 2021 outbound Detroit group.

The qualification will take place in two stages:

1. preliminary stage in March 2021
2. final stage after the end of the 2020/21 summer semester

Requirements for candidates

The qualification is open to 2nd and 3rd year students of Bachelor studies at FA WUT.

Initial qualification

People who send the following documents by e-mail to katarzyna.mitroszewska@pw.edu.pl by March 14, 2021 are invited to pre-qualify.

Documents:

1. registration card;
2. signed financial commitment;
3. signed exchange regulations.

Shortlisted candidates are required to provide the originals of the above-mentioned documents to the Dean's Office of WAPW.

Candidates are selected on the basis of the number of points from the highest to the lowest. The number of points is the sum of the grades from the following project activities:

1. For 2nd year students:
sem. I Elements of design;
sem. II Introduction to design;
sem. III. Architectural design 1;

2. For 3rd year students:
sem. III. Architectural design 1;
sem. IV Architectural design 2;
sem. V Architectural design 3;

Exchange participants should know English sufficiently to enable them to communicate freely. For this purpose, a qualifying examination will be conducted. People who have completed the technical English language course at WA PW with a grade: 4; 4.5; 5 - are exempt from the exam and the grade is included in the overall score.

Certificates entitling to exemption from the exam:

- CAE with a score of A or B or C; the grades included in the total score are respectively: 5 or 4.5 or 4 included in the total score.
- CPE with a score of A, B, C; the grade included in the overall score is 5.
- TOEFL (Internet-based test) with a score of 110 - the overall score is 5, from 102 - 4.5, from 79 - 4. The certificate must be valid on the day of the language exam.
- IELTS with a score of 8 - the grade included in the overall score is 5, from 7.5 - 4.5, from 6.5 - 4. The certificate must be valid on the day of the language exam.

- International Baccalaureate (IB) - the grade included in the overall score is 5.
- University C1 Academic Examination (not General!).

Students exempted from the exam should report within the prescribed period to Magdalena Walenta, PhD in order to confirm the certificate validity.

At the pre-qualification stage a grade is added to the overall score from the English language exam.

Final Qualification

As a result of the final qualification, 8 students will be selected for the trip to Detroit and two additional standby people who will step in in case of random events. The number of participants may change after the end of the enrollment at the University of Detroit Mercy.

Candidates are selected on the basis of the number of points consecutively from the highest to the lowest.

As a result of the pre-qualification of the following projects, the sum of the grades is added to the number of points obtained:

1. For 2nd year students:
sem. IV Architectural design 2
2. For 3rd year students:
sem. VI Architectural design 4

Candidates subject to final qualification are required to fulfill the following conditions:

- completion of all other subjects and internships from the entire current study program (completed semesters of studies - confirmed by the Dean's Office on the registration card) and obtaining absolute registration for the academic year 2021/2022 (except for internships not completed as a result of an epidemic situation - however, it should be remembered that it will be necessary to complete the internship before the diploma) in June 2021;
- fulfillment of financial commitments (does not apply to students from the standby list - these will be required to pay after possible entry on the final list);
- payment of tuition fees for the 2020/21 summer semester by students of English-speaking and extramural studies. Students of English-speaking and extramural studies enrolled in the study may apply to the Dean of FA WUT for an exemption from tuition fees for the 2021/2022 winter semester.

The final list of students qualified for the trip will be announced on July 5, 2021.

Costs

The trip is organized on a self-financing basis. The cost is approx. PLN 8,700 (payable in 3 installments). The above cost does not include the price of the plane ticket and visa fees.
